Welcome home to St. Andrew Palm Sunday of Lent – Year C

Dear brothers and sisters,

Holy Week is here, Easter is here. What we have been preparing for, the object of our hope is here. We started Lent with Ash Wednesday, when we received ashes and were reminded that we came from dust and that to dust we are to return. However, we were not only reminded of our mortality, but we also got a call from Jesus, saying, "Repent and believe in the gospel." This is a call to commitment.

Yes, the ashes remind us that God formed us from the soil, "la terra", when he created Adam and Eve. So, we are soil. Now that the cremation has become more common these days than before, seeing the ashes of our beloved ones in the urn reminds us that we are really ashes.

But the ashes don't only remind us of our death, our frailty and our nothingness. It also reminds us that when we burn our sins and leave them behind, when we repent and receive God's mercy and forgiveness, the residue or what remains is nothing compared to the volume and weight we were carrying before we were forgiven.

At the beginning of Lent, we made some commitments with ourselves, with neighbour and with God to leave the old ways and embrace a life acceptable to God. We promised to renounce sin and believe in the Gospel. We promised to undergo conversion.

Now it's the right time to make an x-ray into our life and see if we fulfilled our commitment. If we failed we have to ask ourselves what happened. Maybe we didn't dedicate enough time, energy and love, to our commitment. This means we lacked the spirit repentance and renewal. However, we are reminded that, though we failed God, he never fails us, he still loves and forgives us.

The Lord gives us another time. This time is the Holy Week, the synthesis of Jesus' earthly life. It's also the synthesis of all our fasting, prayer and almsgiving during the forty days with Jesus in this our earthly desert. This is the last chance before Easter to fulfill the fruit of your desire for spiritual renewal. The Lord says, "At a favourable time I listened to you, and on a day of salvation I helped you. Behold, now is the favourable time, behold, now is the day of salvation," 2 Cor 6:2. Don't allow yourself to miss this God's offer.

JESUS IS CALLING YOU BACK TO CHURCH

Dear parishioners, this time is really favourable for us. We have not celebrated a normal Holy Week for two years. To be exact, parishes last celebrated traditional Holy Week together in 2019. Then came the pandemic and its on-and-off lockdowns and social distancing. The coronavirus and its restrictions paralyzed the whole world and its institutions, including our churches.

Now that the world is opening up again, it's a golden chance to come back to our churches and pray together. Let's celebrate as a community, the passion, death and resurrection of our Lord. He has suffered with us and continues to do so during the pandemic.

He is the source of our life and our hope. Let us encourage our families and friends to come back to Church and celebrate the

Easter festivities. Coronavirus separated people. Social distance distanced people, it's now time to come back, heal the wounds of division and separation and celebrate the paschal mystery as one family.

Parishioners all over the world are asking their pastors "what is the program of Holy Week?" It's always good to give this program on paper, on social media and to announce it in Church. But God also asks you, "What is your Holy Week program for me? Where is it" You don't need to write it on paper or in social media. God wants it written in your heart and in the way you treat others. What's your Holy Week schedule for Jesus this week?


