#### **UGANDA MARTYRS' DAY 2022**

Some of the fruits of these African Martyrs

In 1939, a Ugandan Priest, Monsignor Joseph Kiwanuka was ordained the first African Catholic Bishop of South of the Sahara. His leadership proved that the African clergy were mature enough to lead the young Church in Uganda and all over Africa.

In July 1969, Pope Paul VI visited Uganda, who after canonizing these martyrs in 1964, wanted to come to kiss the African soil and celebrate Mass at the Martyrs' Shrine in Namugongo, Kampala. It was during his address to the African conference of Catholic Bishops that he made what is both a mandate and a prophecy, when he told the African people: "Be missionaries to yourselves. In other words, you Africans must now continue, upon this Continent, the building up of the Church." This call has gone outside Africa, because now Africans are not only missionaries to themselves, but to the whole world.

During one of his homilies in Kampala, he made what is both a mandate and a prophecy, when he told the African people: "Be "Missionaries to yourselves. In other words, you Africans must now continue, upon this Continent, the building up of the Church." This has become true because now Africans are not only missionaries to themselves, but to the whole world.

The blood of the martyrs irrigated the African soil and made it move from a missionary receiving Church to a missionary sending Church. By God's grace we are able to send missionaries to all the continents. It's a sign of gratitude to share the fruit of faith with those who shared it with us first. We find African men and women in Parishes, schools, hospitals, nursing homes, and other institutions in the whole world. Currently, there are many native religious congregations in Africa.

There we 22 Catholic and 23 Anglican martyrs. These are the names of the Catholic martyrs killed between 1885-86: Ambrosius Kibuuka, Anatoli Kiriggwajjo, Andrew Kaggwa, Antanansio Bazzekuketta, Bruno Sserunkuuma, Charles Lwanga, Denis Ssebuggwawo Wasswa, Gonzaga Gonza, Gyavira Musoke, James Buuzabalyawo, John Maria Muzeeyi, Joseph Mukasa, Kizito, (he was about 15 years old), Lukka Baanabakintu, Matiya Mulumba, Mbaga Tuzinde, Mugagga Lubowa, Mukasa Kiriwawanvu, Nowa Mawaggali, Ponsiano Ngondwe, and two who were martyred in 1918: Blessed David Okelo and Blessed Gildo Irwa.

Here at St. Andrew's Catholic Parish, next month, on June 4th we will celebrate the feast of St. Charles Lwanga, Mattia Mulumba and companions, traditionally known as the Uganda Martyrs. We shall have the honour of hosting our chief pastor, His Eminence Cardinal Thomas Collins, the archbishop of Toronto, as the main celebrant of the Eucharist at 11:00 a.m. You are all invited to participate.
