

Habemus Papam! We have a Pope!

Cardinal Robert Prevost, a 69-year-old from Chicago, has been elected as the first US-born Pontiff and will be known as Pope Leo XIV. Before his election, he served as a missionary with the Augustinians in South America and held significant leadership roles, including Bishop of Chiclayo, Peru, before being appointed Cardinal by Pope Francis in 2023. He is also the first Augustinian Pope and the second Pontiff from the Americas after Pope Francis.

In his first address, Pope Leo XIV began with the words, "Peace be with you all!" — echoing the risen Christ, the Good Shepherd who laid down His life for God's flock. He emphasized that this peace is unarmed, disarming, and rooted in God's unconditional love. Reflecting on the blessing given by Pope Francis to Rome and the world, he affirmed, "God loves us, God loves you all, and evil will not prevail!"

Expressing gratitude to the Cardinals for choosing him and to the faithful of Chiclayo for their unwavering support, he also reminded the Church of Saint Augustine's words: "With you I am a Christian, and for you I am a bishop." Pope Leo XIV urged all to journey together as missionary people, building bridges through dialogue and charity.

Let us pray for Pope Leo XIV, asking the Lord to grant him wisdom, strength, and compassion as he leads the Church forward.

A Joyful Celebration of First Holy Communion!




