RCIA 2025-2026 Registration Process Update!

Following a recent meeting with our clergy and RCIA team, guidelines have been updated for the acceptance of candidates into the 2025-2026 RCIA/RCIC and Infant Baptism program's at St. Andrew's Parish. To ensure sincere faith formation, all prospective RCIA candidates will now be referred to the Pastor or Associate Pastor for a personal interview prior to registration. A registration form will only be given at the discretion of the interviewing priest.

For those residing within parish boundaries: Candidates may be registered after the interview or asked to actively participate in parish life for a certain period of time before joining the program. Children will only be eligible for the RCIC Baptism program after their parents have received the Sacraments of Initiation.

For those living outside the parish: Candidates will generally be encouraged to register for RCIA at their local parish. Thank you for your understanding.


