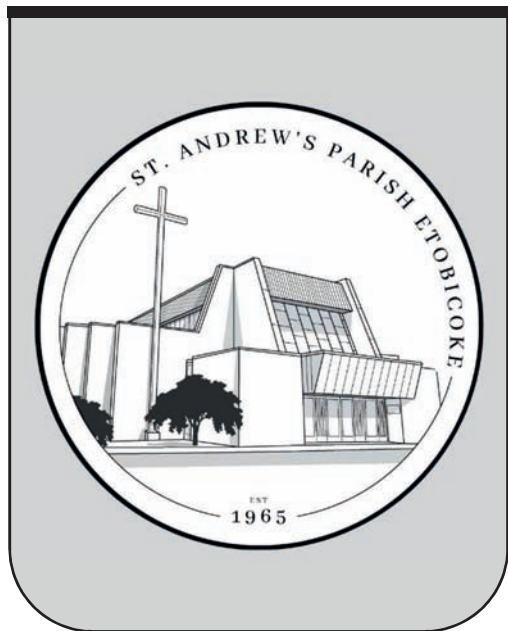

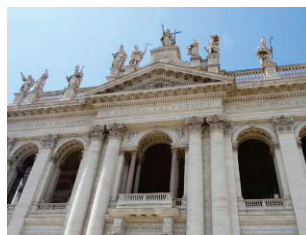

FEAST OF THE DEDICATION OF THE LATERAN BASILICA

While many associate St. Peter's Basilica with the pope, his actual cathedral is the Archbasilica of St. John Lateran—the mother church of all churches in the world and the pope's seat as Bishop of Rome. Originally built in the 4th century on land given by Emperor Constantine, it has

endured fires, earthquakes, and wars yet remains the central symbol of unity for the Catholic Church. The present structure, completed in 1646 under Pope Innocent X, features grand statues of Christ and the saints, and beneath its altar rests the wooden table where tradition holds St. Peter once celebrated Mass.



The Vatican's Dicastery for the Doctrine of the Faith has **rejected the title's 'Co-Redemptrix' and 'Mediatrice'** as they have been found to **not be suitable Marian titles**, reaffirming Christ as the sole Redeemer and Mediator. This was decided in the document "*Mater Populi Fidelis*" which was a document *approved* by Pope Leo XIV and made by the Dicastery of Doctrine of the Faith.

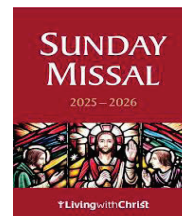
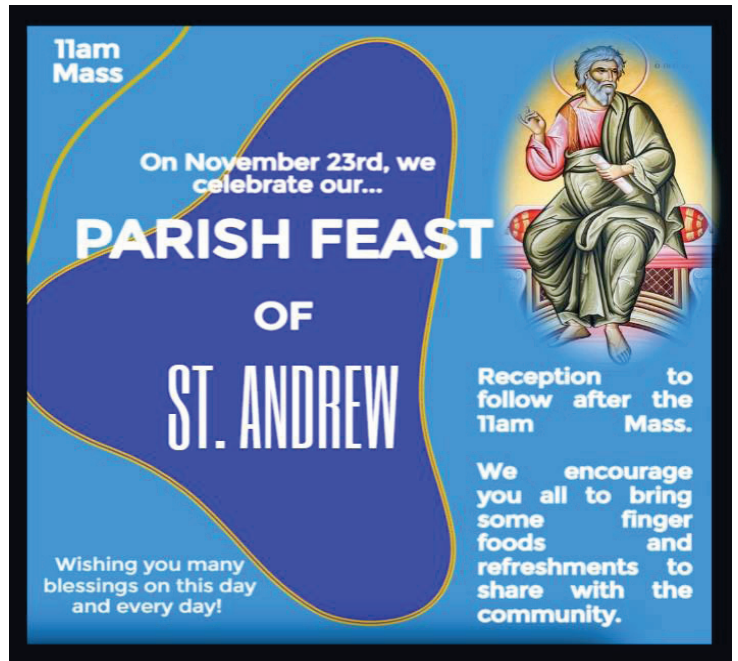
2025 Parish Collection - November 15/16
